**‘VOLUNTEERS OF THE YEAR’ NOMINATIONS SOUGHT,  
ACCEPTED THROUGH JANUARY 28, 2011**

WAUKESHA, Wis.—United Way in Waukesha County’s Volunteer Center seeks nominations within four categories by 4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 28, 2011. Award categories include Volunteer of the Year, Youth Volunteer of the Year, Volunteer Group of the Year, and Business Partner of the Year. Awards winners will be recognized at the annual Volunteer Recognition & Celebration Event on April 12, 2011.

**Nominations are sought for the following awards:**

- *Volunteer of the Year* – Recognizes an individual, or couple, who has provided exemplary volunteer service to a nonprofit organization within Waukesha County.
- *Youth Volunteer of the Year* – Presented to a high school student who has provided exemplary volunteer service to a nonprofit organization within Waukesha County.
- *Group Volunteers of the Year* – Recognizes a team of three or more volunteers (adults, youth, or combination) that has initiated and implemented a project or program with benefits to a community within Waukesha County.
- *Business Partner of the Year Award* – Presented to a business that has mobilized a group of employee volunteers from within to help a community within Waukesha County with an exemplary project or program.

A panel of community leaders, independent of United Way, will review all nominations and select one winner for each of the four Award Categories who ‘Inspires by Example.’ The winners will be recognized at the Volunteer Recognition & Celebration Event and will be awarded \$500 payable to their choice of designated nonprofits.

The United Way Volunteer Center has annually presented these awards for more than 30 years to individuals and groups who make Waukesha County a better place by generously donating their time and talent to serving others.
